#### **Entry**

This is an open competition. Both individual and group entries are welcome.

#### **Maximum Number of Submission**

There is no limit to number of works to be submitted. However, when submitting works (or group of works) under different concepts, please submit separate entry forms for each set of works.

### **Application Essentials**

All works must be complete, original and unreleased. There is no limit on size. However, organiser may decide not to show the works that may cause difficulty in transportation and display or for those that are too fragile. The works submitted from abroad will not be for sale. Please do not submit any display accessories that are not part of the work. All works that do not meet the above requirements will be excluded from the selection procedure.

If damage is due to our negligence, within the limit of the liability insurance (theft non-collateral) and up to 70% of the declared price (when not applicable for liability insurance, up to 35% of the declared price), the compensation for work will be paid. However, since the amount of compensation will be assessed by the insurance company, the insured amount may not necessarily be fully compensated.


