Requirements

Creation of works under the theme "Jewellery" with no restriction on material.

Entry

This is an open competition. Both individual and group entries are welcome.

Maximum Number of Submission

There is no limit to number of works to be submitted. However, when submitting works (or group of works) under different concepts, please apply separately.

Application Essentials

•The work must have been completed within the last two years (after September 2023).

•The work must not contain works that have been presented in other public exhibitions or exhibitions. (Works that have been presented on campus, such as graduation/completion exhibitions, or in solo or group exhibitions at a rental gallery, are acceptable.)

•The work must not contain works that have been previously sold and distributed.

•The assessed value per entry must be less than or equal to ¥300,000. *If you win a prize or are selected for an award, you will not be allowed to sell or exhibit the same type of work as your entry until the end of the exhibition.

*If you are submitting an entry from abroad, your work will not be sold, but you must indicate the assessed value of each work in the price box on the Application Sheet.

*There are no size restrictions, but the organiser reserves the right to refuse exhibits that are not structurally sound or strong enough to be displayed, stored, moved or used, or that are easily damaged.

*Please do not submit any display accessories that are not part of the work.

All works that do not meet the above requirements will be excluded from the selection procedure.

Application Procedure

* For overseas applicants, please make sure to fill in the price value in this sheet, for each work as our source for calculating insurance coverage (works will not be sold). The total amount of assessed value has to be less than or equal to ¥300,000. When the value is not indicated, the application may not be accepted. These prices are also used when returning your work. Customs duties may apply when the work is transported. If the work can be re-exported duty-free, we will do so, but depending on the method of transport, duty-free procedures may not be possible. Please note that in such cases, the applicant will be responsible for any customs duties incurred. 2) Two images of the entry works. The file format must be JPEG and the size must not exceed 2MB, 2000X3000pixel.

A: An image showing all works in their complete appearance. (This is used for confirming works.)

B: Images of models wearing the works (If there are multiple copies, they must be kept on one page.)

*Please read the notes on the second page of Application Sheet carefully and complete the necessary information.

After receiving the above 1) & 2), we will inform you about the payment of application fees by email.

Application Fee

General: ¥13,000 / Under 25 years old ※as of 31st July 2025: ¥8,000 (both including return delivery fee of ¥4,000)

Invoice will be sent to applicants by email after the receipt of Application Sheet, etc.

The entry will be considered as complete the moment when payment has been confirmed, so please make sure to precede the application as soon as possible. The payment deadline is Friday, 25th July.

*The application fee once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.

Submission of Works

Please deliver the following 1) & 2) by EMS or air parcel with prepaid transport insurance.

1) Works with labels indicating the name of the artist and item number (see sample label) sealed or tied onto the back of each work. *Make sure that all works are the same as those shown on the image sent at the application. Works that differ from the image may not be accepted.

Parcels must be received between Tuesday, 29th July and Sunday, 10th August, 2025.

All transport costs, customs duties and fees are to be borne by the applicant.

As the entries will be returned to the applicant without being sold, we will take care of the 'duty-free re-export' procedure if we are contacted by customs at the time of customs clearance. However, if you use a carrier (FedEx, DHL, UPS, etc.) who will advance customs duties at customs clearance and charge them later, we will not be able to apply for duty-free re-export. If this is the case, please arrange for all costs to be paid by the applicant at the time of transport. The organiser is not liable for any damage caused during delivery. In case the work is not assessable due to severe damage, the application might not be accepted. Even in that case, the application fee will not be refunded.

Announcement of Results

After examination of the works, applicants of all award-winning and selected works will be informed by the website **in the afternoon (JST) on Sunday, 31st August (provisional).** For those that are not selected, the result will be known by the return of their works. Individual inquiry will not be answered. We will not be able to answer any questions concerning the results or to accommodate any requests for explanation.

Return of Works

Works not selected: To be shipped early September 2025 Selected works: To be shipped early January 2026 In case there are both selected and non-selected works within the same delivery parcel, the non-selected work will be returned together with the selected work unless there is a special request.

Storage Policy

Once we receive your work, we will keep and handle them with the greatest possible care. If your work undergoes some damage due to an inevitable accident beyond our control, we will not be responsible for the damage. As for the work that is damaged during the examination, easy to break or damaged due to instability when displaying, we are not responsible for any guarantee. If the damage is caused by our gross negligence, we will compensate up to 70% of the application amount (or up to 35% of the application amount if liability insurance does not apply), within the limits of our liability insurance (natural disasters and theft are not covered). However, since the amount of compensation will be assessed by the insurance company, the insured amount may not necessarily be fully compensated.

<u>Rights</u>

All applicants are considered to have agreed to the following conditions by submitting their entry to the ITAMI International Craft Exhibition:

-The organiser holds all rights on award-winning and other selected works regarding the display, publication on exhibition catalogue / PR printed matters, usage of photographs, etc. for the promotion of the exhibition, publicity announcements and citation to conferences, etc. -The organiser holds all rights to duplicate and/or distribute photographs in order to realize the aforementioned acts.

<u>Others</u>

Please read these application guidelines carefully before submitting your entry. By submitting an entry to this exhibition, you are deemed to have agreed to these terms and conditions.

All information submitted by the applicants will be used for various contact purposes by under the security policy of Itami City Museum of Art, History and Culture. It also provides the carrier with the necessary information when returning the artwork. As for the award-winning and other selected works, the information will also be supplied to the companies and organisations in relations to the display of works and publishing of the exhibition catalogue. Otherwise, no personal information will be released or disclosed to a third party without the permission of applicants (except for when the disclosure is requested by law).

* A travelling show for some of the awarded or selected works may be held after the exhibition.
